| Immensity | Reciter | <p>This is what the Lord says: “Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for me? Where will my resting place be?”</p> <p>Isaiah 66:1</p> |
| Infinitude | Reciter | <p>Your love, Lord, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies. Your righteousness is like the highest mountains, your justice like the great deep. You, Lord, preserve both people and animals.</p> <p>Psalms 36:5-6</p> |
| Infinitude | Reciter | <p>How great is God—beyond our understanding! The number of his years is past finding out.</p> <p>Job 36:26</p> |
| Goodness | Reciter | <p>“Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!”</p> <p>Matthew 7:9-11 (same as Luke 11:11)</p> |
| Perfect | Reciter | <p>The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple. The precepts of the Lord are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are radiant, giving light to the eyes. The fear of the Lord is pure, enduring forever. The decrees of the Lord are firm, and all of them are righteous. They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the honeycomb. By them your servant is warned; in keeping them there is great reward.</p> <p>Psalms 19:7-11</p> |
| Justice | Reciter | <p>The Lord reigns forever; he has established his throne for judgment. He rules the world in righteousness and judges the peoples with equity.</p> <p>Psalms 9:7-8</p> |
| Holiness | Reciter | <p>At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. “Woe to me!” I cried. “I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty.”</p> <p>Isaiah 6:4-5</p> |

| Omnipresent | Reciter | <p>Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast. If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you.</p> <p>Psalm 139:7-12</p> |
| Immanent | Reciter | <p>Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.</p> <p>Isaiah 7:14</p> |
| Graceful | Reciter | <p>But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.</p> <p>Romans 5:8</p> |
| Merciful | Reciter | <p>The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger forever; he does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.</p> <p>As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him; for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust.</p> <p>The life of mortals is like grass, they flourish like a flower of the field; the wind blows over it and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more. But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord's love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children's children—with those who keep his covenant and remember to obey his precepts.</p> <p>Psalm 103:8-18</p> |
