Key Points

A perfect mix of six cute kids, a worship leader, and beautiful Scripture, this recitation has kids giving advice to Dads.

Recitation Delivery Notes

As great as the kids are, it is the worship leader who really makes this recitation enjoyable. If the worship leader has a good rapport with the kids, then this recitation is lively and fun—with a few insightful passages. The reciters each give a short piece of advice, such as “Be kind” and then follow that with a passage of Scripture. They cite the reference and then the passage. Enjoy matching the kids with the passage that suits their personality and tailor the delivery to them.

	<i>kids run up and surround the worship leader</i>
Worship Leader	So you have some advice, do you? Of course, we want to make sure that your advice is sound, so I expect that you have a verse from the Bible that will back up your advice
	<i>kids become quiet, contemplating what was said, and sit down on the stage steps, assuming the "Thinker" pose</i>
Worship Leader	Gary: Do you have a great dad?
Reciter #1	Yes, I do.
Worship Leader	Do you love your dad?
Reciter #1	Yes, I do.
Worship Leader	Do you have some advice?
Reciter #1	Yes, I do.
Worship Leader	What is your advice?
Reciter #1	First of all, love the Lord. Proverbs 14:26 In the fear of the Lord one has strong confidence, and his children will have a refuge.

	<i>Reciter#4 steps down (maybe high-five from the worship leader)</i> <i>Reciter #5 steps up</i>
Worship Leader	Hello, Reciter #5, what is your advice?
Reciter #5	Be wise with your money. Proverbs 13:22 A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, but the sinner's wealth is laid up for the righteous.
	<i>Reciter#5 steps down (maybe high-five from the worship leader)</i> <i>Reciter #6 steps up</i>
Worship Leader	Hello, Reciter #6, what do you want to share with fathers?
